

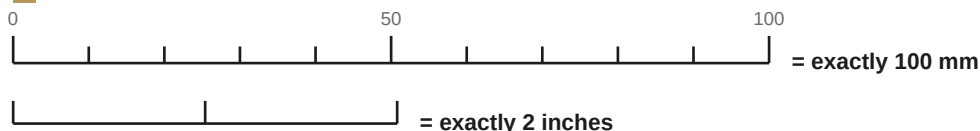
Printable Ring Sizer

Print this page at 100% / Actual size.

Turn off "Fit to page", "Shrink to fit" and every other scaling option, then check Step 1 before you cut anything out.

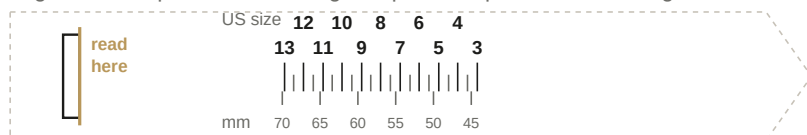
STEP 1 CHECK THE PRINT SCALE



Hold a ruler against both bars. If either one is off, the page printed at the wrong scale and every reading below will be wrong.

STEP 2 MEASURE YOUR FINGER

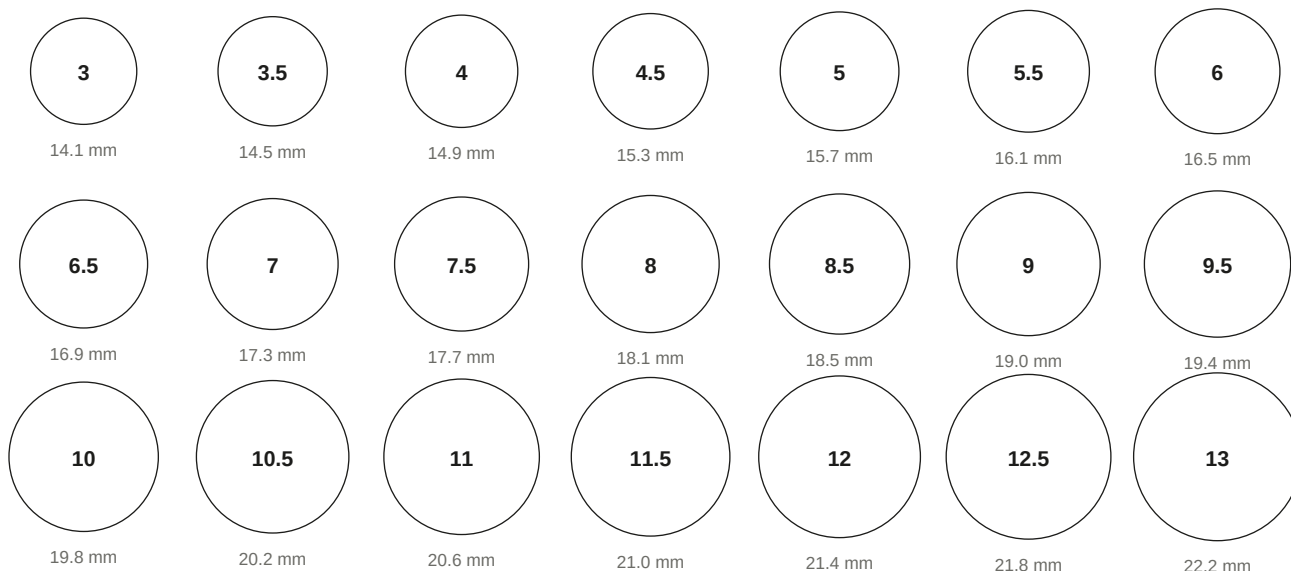
Cut out the strip below along the outer line, then cut the short slot at the left end. Wrap the strip around the base of your finger with the printed side facing out, push the pointed end through the slot, and pull it comfortably snug against the skin.



Landed between two sizes? Take the larger one if your knuckle is wider than the base of your finger, or if the band you want is 6 mm or wider.

STEP 3 OR MEASURE A RING YOU ALREADY WEAR

Place a ring that already fits the right finger over the circles below. The correct size is the circle whose outline is just covered by the inside edge of the band. Use a ring worn on the same finger and the same hand as the one you are ordering.



Before you order

- Measure in the afternoon at room temperature. Fingers are at their smallest in the morning and in cold weather.
- Take the reading three times. If the readings disagree, start again rather than averaging a loose one and a tight one.
- A band 6 mm or wider sits tighter than a thin band at the same size. Half a size up is the usual starting point.
- For a made-to-order ring, send us both the finger base and the knuckle measurement and we will size the piece around both.
